The Ports Regulator of South Africa wishes to establish a Tariff Methodology for port tariffs over the medium term. The Regulator intends on publishing a draft Methodology on **Friday, 03 March 2017 for public comment**.

Port users, stakeholders, and interested parties are requested to comment on the various elements of the Methodology, including the methodology period and the type of methodology to be implemented. Furthermore, comments on the suitability of the Risk Free Rate, the applicability of the proposed Beta, the treatment of the NPA's cost of debt, as well as the inclusion of an efficiency variable in the Methodology, amongst others, are requested.

The final Tariff methodology that will result from this process will inform the way in which the port tariffs are calculated over the medium term (and consequently the revenue the Ports Regulator allows the NPA to raise).
